HOW DOES IT WORK?

Team members dedicate a few hours each week for six months, resulting in approximately 150 to 200 hours of implementation time for your organization.

Our process begins by defining the scope and requirements to ensure clarity on the project deliverables. Common Impact screens corporate employees to ensure your team has the right skillset, provides an orientation to all participants, defines milestones and checkpoints, and monitors the project to ensure success. At the end of the project, we measure the social impact and recognize the employees for their contribution.
